1. ASSESSMENT

The Coalition for Youth Ministry Excellence (CYME) is a two-year experientially integrated vocational youth ministry training program. <https://www.coalitionforministry.com>

CYME has high academic standards, well qualified instructors, and appropriate course workloads.

2. TRANSFER DETAILS

Students who successfully complete the two-year Coalition for Youth Ministry Excellence training program will receive 60 credits of transfer credit toward the BA-PT: Youth Work (this includes credit for internship which is usually a Columbia signature course).

Students may also use their CYME transfer credits toward other Columbia programs. However, the amount of transfer credit will depend upon the requirements of that particular program. Transfer covering internship credits in non-Youth Work majors will be considered on a case by case basis.

This plan is also applicable for students who attend CYME after several years at Columbia. However, in such cases some adjustments to the plan may be required due to courses already taken. Individualized transfer plans that ensure as much transfer as possible will be drafted for students in this particular situation.

3. TRANSFER PROCEDURE

An official transcript from CYME will be required before Columbia can grant transfer credits.
