Job Description: Vespers Team Leader



Worship Arts Leaders are required to meet the following expectations:

- They must be a mature, responsible student, who is respected within the CBC community.
- They are expected to uphold all CBC community standards.
- They are expected to have completed at least one year of academic studies at CBC.
- They are expected to have a 2.5 cumulative GPA.

Compensation:

- The Vespers Team Leader will receive a \$2,100.00 stipend for the academic year.
- The Vespers Team Leader may be eligible to receive Service Practicum or Internship credit for their role.

Commitment: September – April; approx. 15 – 20 hours per week.

AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY:

1. Choose the Vespers team together with Faculty Advisor.

This is done through auditions and individual interviews based on the following criteria:

- Motives for joining a worship team
- Understanding of worship as a lifestyle
- Past experience
- Demonstrated experience
- Level of commitment, availability and dedication

2. Choose a Vespers Design team of student volunteers and chair a weekly design team meeting.

It is helpful to have representatives from both Spiritual Life and Arts Committees of Student Council on the design team as well as one member of the band.

3. Lead regular rehearsals in preparation for the weekly Vespers worship time.

Times of rehearsals are determined by the team collectively. Count on 10-12 hours of time each week divided between design team meetings, band rehearsal, administrative prep and set up/tear down.

4. Oversee the preparation of ProPresenter and/or other media materials for the weekly Vespers service.

5. Prepare and print music for weekly rehearsals:

Student Development pays for the photocopying of charts, lead sheets, and other non-musical resources for the Vespers service.

6. Plan and lead the weekly Vespers worship service.

Vespers is a one-hour, on-campus worship gathering every Tuesday evening from 9-10pm, often with prayer preceding and/or following the corporate worship time.

7. Meet weekly with the Supervisor for feedback, counsel, prayer and encouragement.

- 8. Meet regularly (recommended weekly) with the assistant Vespers Leader for planning and brainstorming
- 9. Attend Leadership Training Week at the beginning of the school year as well as weekly Leadership Connections meetings with other student leaders on Wednesday afternoons.
- 10. Facilitate various planned and spontaneous team-building experiences for both the Vespers band and Design team as able.

Social times, debriefing times, casual interaction including off-campus gatherings. Also, serve as a worship team in off-campus settings as opportunities arise and as the team is available.
