JOB DESCRIPTION: The Children and Family Services Program offers anticipatory grief and

grief support for ages 3-1 0; providing programs to comfort children on their personal journey of grief and loss. Services offered include 8 sessions

of one-to-one companioning where different aspects of play and art

therapy are explored. Children have opportunities to learn about their grief

feelings and develop coping strategies to regulate emotions.

Practicum students have the opportunity to shadow companioning

sessions and participate in events and groups.
