POSITION TITLE: Imagine (Special Needs Ministry) Volunteer

JOB DESCRIPTION: Volunteers will be a buddy to a child needing extra support in either our regular children's ministry program or in our Imagine program. Imagine is a specialized program that gives a high level of support to children and youth who need extra support. We run an adapted service in Imagine with the remaining time being highly play based.
