

I. SPIRITUAL & CHARACTER FORMATION

EDUCATIONAL GOAL: To foster students' spiritual and character formation and their commitment to God's holistic mission for the world.

Core Objectives

- Demonstrate growth in Christian discipleship and transformation towards holistic Christian character (i.e., joy, compassion, honesty, integrity, work ethic, purity, trustworthiness).
- 2. Demonstrate healthy relational skills as an expression of one's commitment to Christian discipleship.
- Demonstrate commitment to God's holistic (spiritual, social environmental) mission of reconciliation and restoration for all creation.
- 4. Demonstrate commitment to active participation in the church and its mission.

Applied Leadership Objectives

- 1. Develop an awareness of one's self, leadership capacity, and leadership potential.
- 2. Develop a practical understanding of sustainability in personal and organizational leadership.

II. CHRISTIAN WORLDVIEW & INTELLECTUAL FORMATION

EDUCATIONAL GOAL: To provide students a foundational knowledge base, and the abilities to think critically and to interact respectfully with the views of others.

Core Objectives

- 1. Demonstrate foundational knowledge of the Bible and the ability to understand the scriptural message.
- Demonstrate the ability to appropriately utilize hermeneutical principles to interpret and apply the Bible.
- 3. Demonstrate an understanding of biblical theology in relation to the formation of a Christian worldview.
- 4. Demonstrate familiarity with evangelical Anabaptism and its contributions to the larger Christian church, historically, theologically, and ethically
- 5. Demonstrate increasing ability in critical thinking
- Demonstrate familiarity with a breadth of subject material in the Humanities, Social Sciences and Natural Science

Applied Leadership Objectives

- Develop an understanding and application of leadership andmanagement, and one's involvement in both.
- 2. Explore, engage, integrate, and articulate a Biblical theology of leadership.
- 3. Develop an understanding of leadership, and organizational behaviour, structure, and design.

III. PREPARATION FOR SERVICE AND MINISTRY IN CHURCH AND WORLD

EDUCATIONAL GOAL: To prepare students for effective service and ministry in the church and in the world particularly in the areas of their chosen field of study.

Core Objectives

- 1. Demonstrate effective and sacrificial service in both team member and team leader ministry roles.
- 2. Demonstrate an ability to facilitate Christian discipleship and growth in others.
- 3. Demonstrate healthy interpersonal skills essential for ministry/leadership.
- 4. Demonstrate increasingly effective communication.
- Demonstrate application of biblical and self understanding to their personal and career direction.
- Demonstrate basic levels of competence in an applied ministry setting

Applied Leadership Objectives

- Develop the ability to lead agroup of people towards a common goal while managing conflict and communicating clearly.
- 2. Discover business as mission.
- Develop a working knowledge of basic accounting principles.
- 4. Develop a growing ability to create and manage culture and change in a variety of contexts.
- 5. Explore and apply empowering leadership through coaching, mentoring, and spiritual directing models.
- 6. Develop innovative ventures.
- 7. Develop an ability to effectively communicate and promote.
- 8. Integrate faith, leadership, and management knowledge and present one's philosophy and theology of applied leadership.
