EDUCATIONAL GOAL: To foster students' spiritual and character formation and their commitment to God's holistic mission for the world.

Core Objectives

- Demonstrate growth in Christian discipleship and transformation towards holistic Christian character (i.e., joy, compassion, honesty, integrity, work ethic, purity, trustworthiness).
- 2. Demonstrate healthy relational skills as an expression of one's commitment to Christian discipleship.
- 3. Demonstrate commitment to God's holistic (spiritual, social environmental) mission of reconciliation and restoration for all creation.
- 4. Demonstrate commitment to active participation in the church and its mission.

II. CHRISTIAN WORLDVIEW & INTELLECTUAL FORMATION

EDUCATIONAL GOAL: To provide students a foundational knowledge base, and the abilities to think critically and to interact respectfully with the views of others.

Core Objectives

- 1. Demonstrate foundational knowledge of the Bible and the ability to understand the scriptural message.
- 2. Demonstrate the ability to appropriately utilize hermeneutical principles to interpret and apply the Bible.
- 3. Demonstrate an understanding of biblical theology in relation to the formation of a Christian worldview.
- 4. Demonstrate familiarity with evangelical Anabaptism and its contributions to the larger Christian church, historically, theologically, and ethically
- 5. Demonstrate increasing ability in critical thinking
- 6. Demonstrate familiarity with a breadth of subject material in the Humanities, Social Sciences and Natural Science

Biblical Studies Objectives

- 1. Columbia's Biblical Studies Program seeks especially to provide students with a thorough knowledge of the Bible, its background, and message.
- 2. H. Columbia's Biblical Studies Program seeks especially to prepare students to properly interpret and apply the biblical text to contemporary issues.
- Columbia's Biblical Studies Program seeks to provide students with a basic foundation in complementary academic disciplines (e.g., history, psychology, anthropology, etc.).

III. PREPARATION FOR SERVICE AND MINISTRY IN CHURCH AND WORLD

EDUCATIONAL GOAL: To prepare students for effective service and ministry in the church and in the world particularly in the areas of their chosen field of study.

Core Objectives

- 1. Demonstrate effective and sacrificial service in both team member and team leader ministry roles.
- 2. Demonstrate an ability to facilitate Christian discipleship and growth in others.
- 3. Demonstrate healthy interpersonal skills essential for ministry/leadership.
- 4. Demonstrate increasingly effective communication.
- 5. Demonstrate application of biblical and self understanding to their personal and career direction.
- 6. Demonstrate basic levels of competence in an applied ministry setting

Biblical Studies Objectives

- 1. Columbia's Biblical Studies Program seeks especially to equip students to be effective communicators.
- 2. Columbia Biblical Studies Program seeks to provide students with skill preparation and practical onsite experience in a service or ministry area

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As noted, the Biblical Studies major requires each student in the program to select a minor. Each of these 18 credit hour minors will provide additional objectives in the Christian Worldview/Intellectual Formation as well as Preparation for Service categories. Students will complete their four credit internship (total of 420 hours of onsite work) in the area of their minor.
