Christian Studies - Online is a 30-credit certificate designed to offer students a flexible way to build a solid foundation in Biblical and Theological Studies. I. SPIRITUAL & CHARACTER FORMATION

EDUCATIONAL GOAL: To foster students' spiritual and character formation and their commitment to God's holistic mission for the world.

Core Objectives

- 1. Demonstrate growth in Christian discipleship and transformation towards holistic Christian character (i.e., joy, compassion, honesty, integrity, work ethic, purity, trustworthiness).
- 2. Demonstrate commitment to God's holistic (spiritual, social environmental) mission of reconciliation and restoration for all creation.
- 3. Demonstrate commitment to active participation in the church and its mission.

II. CHRISTIAN WORLDVIEW & INTELLECTUAL FORMATION

EDUCATIONAL GOAL: To provide students a foundational knowledge base, and the abilities to think critically and to interact respectfully with the views of others.

Core Objectives

- 1. Demonstrate foundational knowledge of the Bible and the ability to understand the scriptural message.
- 2. Demonstrate the ability to appropriately utilize hermeneutical principles to interpret and apply the Bible.
- 3. Demonstrate an understanding of biblical theology in relation to the formation of a Christian worldview.
- 4. Demonstrate increasing ability in critical thinking.
