

ENROLLMENT, RETENTION, COMPLETION AND EMPLOYMENT OUTCOMES

Columbia seeks to provide meaningful information about the health and effectiveness of our ministry as a college. To that end, we publish this annual report that capture few key indicators. A brief description of each is offered below.

Enrollment – this is a simple annual report of the number of incoming students in the fall semester.

Retention Rates – the percentage of students who continue in their studies at the college from first year of enrollment to the same period the following year (note: graduates are included in retained student numbers).

Completion Rates – this is a measurement of what percentage of an incoming cohort of Columbia students go on to complete an academic program at the college within six years.

Employment or Educational Outcomes – these provide annual updates on employment or post-graduate educational outcomes for Columbia degree graduates.
