



2025 SUMMER JOB – JOB DESCRIPTION TAPESTRY YOUTH MINISTRY THE TAPESTRY CHURCH

Hiring young adults (age 21+) or older for a summer internship with Tapestry Youth.

OBJECTIVE

The objective of this position is to provide young leaders opportunities to:

- Learn and gain practical experience in volunteer ministry with middle- and high-schoolers.
- Learn leadership skills and be trained through teamwork for future vocation.
- Grow in personal relationship with Jesus Christ and develop care for community through active service.
- Play an integral part in planning and implementing summer programs for the TapYouth ministry.
- Gain broader experience in Pastoral Ministry through optional ministry “shadowing” experiences at Tapestry Richmond.

REQUIREMENTS

- Faith commitment to Jesus Christ and testimony to active relationship with Him.
- Desire to minister to youth ranging in ages, needs, and stages of development (middle- to high-school).
- Experience, skill, and knowledge in working with youth.
- Good (inter-)personal and organizational skills.
- Desire to collaborate and work in a team.
- Ability to lead small/large groups of youth.
- Ability to create and implement ideas, programs, and experiences.
- Experience with organizing retreats, camps, and other youth programs.
- Class 5 Passenger Vehicle License would be an asset.
- Applicants have to pass the Criminal Record Check required by legislation.

EMPLOYMENT PERIOD AND WORKING HOURS

(Number of positions and employment periods are subject to Government Summer Job Grant approval)

- one position from June 30 to August 29, 2025 (for the 9-week position)
- salary to be paid \$19.00/hour. 30 hours per week for 270 hours total.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

WEEKLY BIBLE STUDY

Work with the ministry directors to:

- Plan, prepare and run the weekly bible study
- Prepare materials for lessons

OKANAGAN GLEANERS x TAPYOUTH CAMP

Work with the ministry directors to:

- Plan and prepare for two weeks of “gleaning”, excursions, and spiritual development for our trip to Okanagan Gleaners in Oliver, BC.
- Organize transportation and aid in driving.
- Ensure health and safety is adequately observed and youth are supervised.
- Ensure all activity leaders have the required materials and resources.
- Provide oversight to grouping and organization of youth.
- Assist training sessions before Gleaners.
- Assist in the purchasing and organizing of materials and equipment.

TAPYOUTH SUMMER EVENTS

Work with the ministry directors to:

- Assist in organizing, planning and running events including:
 - Middle-school days (Aka “4:12 Weekend”)
 - Grad Retreat
 - 604-Richmond events
 - Leader team-building socials.
