

## **JOB DESCRIPTION: TRAVELLING MINISTRY TEAM LEADER**



### **Worship Arts Leaders are required to...**

- ...be mature, responsible students, respected within the CBC community.
- ...uphold all CBC community standards.
- ...have completed at least one year of academic studies at CBC.
- ...maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA.

### **Compensation:**

- The TMT Leader will receive a \$2000.00 stipend for the academic year.
- The TMT Leader may be eligible to receive Service Practicum credit.

**Commitment:** September – April; approx. 12-15 hours per week

**Supervisor:** Mark Carroll, Worship Arts Program Associate

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### **Responsibilities:**

**Auditions and team selection:** The TMT leader plays a role in selecting the Travelling Ministry Team for the academic year, alongside the faculty advisor and other student leaders. Auditions take place during the first week of classes in September.

**Program planning:** The TMT leader works with the faculty supervisor to plan and coordinate visits to various ministry venues throughout the year. This responsibility includes choosing various elements for worship leading and performance sets that will be used in the team's touring ministry (music, Scripture readings, prayers, etc.), creating service outlines for each ministry venue, and creating the necessary audio and media details as required by the ministry venues.

**Rehearsals:** The TMT leader is responsible to lead their team in preparing music and other worship elements for their worship leading and performance sets throughout the year. Musically, this requires leading the team members in choosing, arranging, and preparing both worship and performance songs, preparing and printing chord charts, and leading effective rehearsals that accomplish learning goals and grow the team's interpersonal relationships and musical skills. The TMT leader will also lead 4-5 book review conversations with the team based on the required reading of "The Worshipping Artist," by Rory Noland.

**Administration:** The TMT leader assists the faculty supervisor with the administrative details of the touring ministry. This may involve coordinating travel, billeting, and meals and connecting with pastors and technical teams from various ministry venues.

**Team Building and Peer Mentoring:** The TMT leader purposefully develops relationships with members of their ministry team to encourage, challenge, and lead in such a way that there is a strong sense of team support, respect, and accountability for effective ministry. The TMT leader also works with the faculty supervisor to plan and implement team events (such as the fall retreat day in September) and to choose a team "uniform" and lead the team on a shopping trip to purchase clothing.

**Leadership Training and Development:** The TMT leader completes a summer leadership assignment and attends leadership training week at the beginning of the academic year and the student leadership retreat at the beginning of the winter semester. They may also be required to attend other leadership training events each year as determined by the Student Development team. The TMT leader also meets weekly with other student leaders for Wednesday afternoon Leadership Connections, and with their supervisor for feedback, counsel, prayer, and encouragement.
