

JOB DESCRIPTION: VESPERS TEAM LEADER



Worship Arts Leaders are required to...

- ...be mature, responsible students, respected within the CBC community.
- ...uphold all CBC community standards.
- ...have completed at least one year of academic studies at CBC.
- ...maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA.

Compensation:

- The Vespers Team Leader will receive a \$2,100.00 stipend for the academic year.
- The Vespers Team Leader may be eligible to receive Service Practicum or Internship credit.

Commitment: September – April; approx. 15-18 hours per week.

Weekly Areas of Responsibility

Vespers (4-5 hours): The vespers team leader is responsible for the planning and implementation of the weekly vespers service, held on Tuesday nights from 9:00-10:00. This responsibility includes all aspects of the service itself and the setup and teardown of the chapel room.

Vespers Design Team (2-3 hours): The vespers team leader is responsible to recruit and select the Vespers Design Team and chair weekly VDT meetings (Wednesdays from 12:00-1:00). This team consists of the vespers assistant leader, representatives from the Campus Life Team in Spiritual Life and Arts, and student volunteers (often with specific portfolios such as facility setup, prayer ministry, and hospitality).

Rehearsals (5-7 hours): The vespers team leader, along with the assistant leader, organizes and runs the weekly vespers team rehearsals. These rehearsals happen on Sunday evenings from 7:00-9:00 and on Tuesday evenings from 7:00-8:30. This responsibility includes ensuring the musicians and media team members are equipped to fulfill their roles (print chord charts and service outlines, communicate audio/visual needs, etc.).

Leadership Development (3-4 hours): The vespers team leader meets weekly with the vespers assistant leader; with other student leaders for Wednesday afternoon Leadership Connections; and regularly with their supervisor for feedback, counsel, prayer, and encouragement.

Other Areas of Responsibility

Auditions and team selection: The vespers team leader plays a role in selecting the vespers team at the beginning of the year, alongside the faculty advisor. Auditions take place during the first week of classes in September.

Peer mentoring and team-building: The vespers leader purposely develops relationships with members of their ministry team to encourage, challenge, and lead in such a way that there is strong team support,

respect, and accountability for effective ministry. They also plan for team-building experiences for both the vespers team and the design team if opportunities arise and the teams are available.

Leadership Training: The vespers team leader completes a summer leadership assignment and attends leadership training week at the beginning of the academic year and the student leadership retreat at the beginning of the winter semester. They may also be required to attend other leadership training events during the year as determined by the Student Development team.
